FACILITY

The City of Miramar has a state-of-the-art facility in the Ansin Sports Complex. The Complex was complete with a 24-acre park features an FTX Mondo running track surface identical to the 2008 Olympic track in Beijing, along with a 9,000 square foot community center. The facility including running track, hurdles, high jump, pole vault, long jump, triple jump, discus, hammer and shot areas are IAAF Certified. The Complex is a perfect host for local, regional, national and international competitions and meets.

AWARDS / SCORING

There will be no team scoring.

MEET CONDUCT

All track events will be run as finals against time. All field events, except high jump and pole vault, will be contested in flights with three trials and nine advancing to the finals. In the finals, each competitor will receive three additional attempts. HJ/PV will be run in continual flights. NCAA rules will be in effect.
