## DIRECTIONS TO MORGAN

### From Baltimore/Washington International Airport

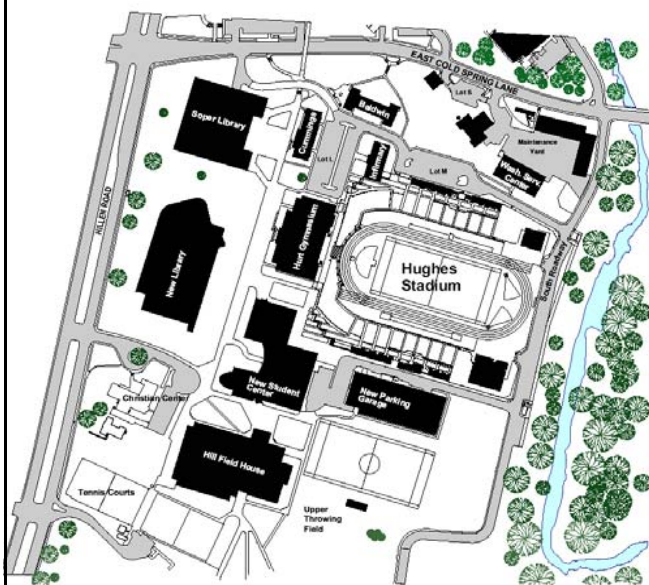
Exit the airport via I-195. Follow the signs for the Baltimore Beltway, I-695 to Towson. Proceed on I-695 to Exit 30A. Perring Parkway/MD-41 S becomes Hillen Rd. Proceed through the E. Cold Spring traffic light, Hill Field House and Hughes Stadium will be located at your first left.

### From Washington D.C., and Richmond

Proceed I-95 North to the Baltimore Beltway, I-695. Exit left (exit is on left) on to I-695 towards Towson to Exit 30A. Perring Parkway/MD-41 S becomes Hillen Rd. Proceed through the E. Cold Spring traffic light, Hill Field House and Hughes Stadium will be located at your first left.

### From Upstate New York City, New Jersey, Philadelphia and Delaware

Follow I-95 South to the Baltimore Beltway, I-695 West (extreme right as you approach I-695). Follow I-695 towards Towson (this is clearly marked) to Exit 30A. Perring Parkway/MD-41 S becomes Hillen Rd. Proceed through the E. Cold Spring traffic light, Hill Field House and Hughes Stadium will be located at your first left.

## SCHEDULE

Athletes must check in at the clerking area prior to the start of their events or they will be scratched. The announcer will make a first call for all competitors and a final call. The meet will operate off of a rolling schedule. Once the meet starts, the events will run in order. It is very important that you and your athletes pay close attention to announcements and the flow of the meet to avoid any missed check-ins. Please be mindful of when your event is. **Do not depend on the hearing of calls.**

## FIELD EVENTS

Field events will operate off of the given time schedule. There will be 4 attempts given. All competitors' first measurable jump or throw will be measured for verification of competing. However, any jump or throw after the first that does not meet the Meets measuring standards will not be measured. The meets measuring standards will be determined based on entries. All competitors will be notified prior to the start of the event.

## EVENT LIMITATION

Four individual per event and 2 relays per event per school.
